CHÂTEAU CADET-BON (GRAND CRU CLASSÉ DE SAINT-ÉMILION)

Located at the edge of the medieval city, on the southern slope of the "Butte du Cadet" hillside, Château Cadet-Bon vineyards benefit from an exceptional soil and micro-climate. As a result from a unique tradition since the XIVth century, this complex and elegant Saint-Émilion rises to the rank of the Grands Crus Classés.

Soil: Sandy-clay Area: 7 hectares

Average age of the vines: 40 years

Varietals: Merlot

Winegrawing: Debudding, shoots and leaves removal, green harvest. Cereals culture, mechanical work of the soil. Simple

and double Guyot pruning.
