Soil: Clayey-limestone hillside and siliceous feet of coast

Area: 22 hectares

Varietals: Merlot, Cabernet franc

Winegrowing: Natural grass, mechanical weeding, manual

thinning, leaf removal, manual harvest

Winemaking: Plot selection in stainless vats, temperature

control, pumping

Aging: 14 to 16 months in French oak casks, of one or two years.

## Tasting notes:

The « Cuvée privée du Château La Gaffelière 2009 » presents a silky texture with refined fig and blackcurrant jams notes, followed by underwood flavours. The finish is long and well-balanced.
