Soil: Gravelly hilltops (Cabernet Sauvignon and Petit Verdot), clay-gravel (Merlot and Cabernet Sauvignon), clay-limestone plots (Merlot) Area: 112 hectares Varietals: 50% Merlot, 50% Cabernet Sauvignon Vinegrowing: Leaf removal, green harvest Winemaking: Temperature control, stainless and wood vats, plots and varietals selection Aging: 16 months in 100% new oak casks

## Tasting notes:

The « Cuvée privée du Château Lascombes 2012 » is appreciated for its subtil and delicate nose of mentholated and spicy black fruits flavors. This wine is refined with beautiful plum and quince notes. Round and powerful, the mouth opens with present but silky tannins. The finih is long and persistent.
