CHÂTEAU LASCOMBES (MARGAUX GRAND CRU CLASSÉ)

Ten generations have contributed to establishing the heritage of Château Lascombes, Grand Cru Classé in 1855. Every one of them has laboured to ensure the excellence of its wines. Fine and harmonious, it reveals all the exquisite character of the Margaux appellation.

Soil: Gravelly hilltops (Cabernet Sauvignon and Petit Verdot), clay-gravel (Merlot and Cabernet Sauvignon), clay-limestone plots (Merlot)

Area: 112 hectares

Varietals: 50% Merlot, 50% Cabernet Sauvignon

Vinegrowing: Leaf removal, green harvest

Winemaking: Temperature control, stainless and wood vats, plots and varietals selection

Aging: 16 months in 100% new oak casks

Tasting notes:

The « Cuvée privée du Château Lascombes 2014 » offers a dark red color highlighted by nice spicy and blackcurrant notes. This wine is surprising by its density in mid-palate. The palate is lively and proposes an ample tannic structure with fruity aromas. We appreciate the long finish.
