## Tasting notes:

The « Cuvée privée du Château Léoville-Poyferré 2013 » is a structured, supple and silky wine. Elegant blackberry and blackcurrant aromas are released, flowing onto the palate with silky and harmonious notes. The finish is fresh and persistent, with long spicy aromas.
